This campaign will change lives. Enclosed is a Vision brochure that gives you more details of the campaign’s purpose and should answer your questions. Please read the material carefully.



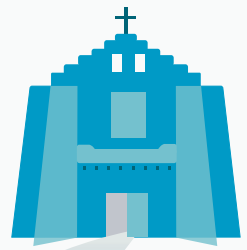
Campaign Prayer:
