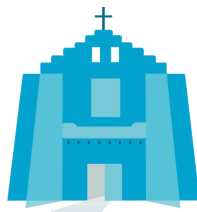

TODAY'S OPERA APPRENTICE

Nationally-acclaimed baritone Matthew Juhlin is widely recognized for his colorful timbre and exquisite musicianship. During the 25-26 season, Matthew will join The Santa Fe Opera for his first year as an apprentice artist, making his SFO debut as the Imperial Commissioner in *Madama Butterfly*, as well as covering the title role in *Eugene Onegin* and Eric Allatini in the American premier of *Lili Elbe*. He will be joining the University of Cincinnati in two productions: *Cendrillon* as Le Surintendant des plaisirs and covering the title role in *Sweeney Todd*. He also will perform with Cincinnati's Musica Sacra as bass soloist for their performance of Haydn's *Harmoniemesse*.

Born in Missouri, Mr. Juhlin is currently pursuing a Master's degree in Voice at the University of Cincinnati's College-Conservatory of Music, studying with Elliot Madore.
